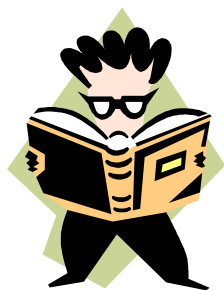

## Logan City School District Considers Major Building Changes

Here is an excerpt from an article that ran in the Herald Journal in March:

The Logan City School District will seek input from the public next month on five major building and remodeling projects that would cost an estimated \$80 million.

Following a 10-month-long facilities assessment, it was recommended to the Board of Education in November that the district rebuild Ellis, Adams and Hillcrest elementary schools, while also approving major remodel-



ing at Logan High School and Mount Logan Middle School. The board is considering several different options for Hillcrest Elementary at 960 N. 1400 East. Because the district owns nearly the entire block, a

new school could be constructed on the open area on the east side of the property, then after it was completed, the old school would be torn down and turned into a play area.

**"Hillcrest is our best property," Garrett said. "If all of our properties were like that, we would love it, because we could build while having a limited impact on the kids."**

The hardest part for the district is determining which direction to face the new two-story building in order to lessen the impact on the surrounding neighborhood and 1500 East, which is a major thoroughfare for the area. The board is considering an option that has the school facing directly east, as well as possibilities that have it looking to the northeast and southeast.
